IIABA National Director Report

I went to the IIABA Fall Board Meetin Minneapolis, ing which was scheduled from 9/14/11 through 9/17/11. Again, the main item was CAP (Consumer Agent Portal), and we were finally advised there are six companies that have signed on, and that CAP now has \$18,000,000 in

its coffers. Of this amount, IIABA has invested \$1,000,000 which we were advised is now worth \$3,000,000. There is a projected 4% return investment our IIABA has total control of the monies and program. Of the six companies who have invested, I only recognized Safeco. I was not familiar with the other five, maybe some of you are. They are Central Insurance Companies, State Auto, Westfield, Selective and Main Street America. They are all in for 3.2 million each. IIABA is still messing around trying to decide what the charge will be

for a lead, but \$15 per lead seemed to be the average. You can of course not answer the lead and incur charges. But is must be mentioned that by the time the lead gets to you, that the potential customer has picked you out, been to your web site etc., so it is probably a pretty sound lead, not like cold calling. There will be more yet to come on this subject.
